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## PILGRIMAGE ITINERARY:

### JULY.26/NEW YORK-LISBON-TOULOUSE:

Board your overnight transatlantic flight to Toulouse. Dinner and breakfast are served on board.

### JULY.27/TOULOUSE-LOURDES:

Early morning arrival in Toulouse and transfer to *Lourdes*. Check in our hotel and first Mass in one of the chapels of Lourdes. Free afternoon to explore or just relax. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes.

(Optional) Candlelight Rosary procession.

### JULY-28-29-30/LOURDES:

During your stay in Lourdes you will walk in the footsteps of *St Bernadette*. Visit the *Boly Mill*, where St Bernadette was born and the "*Cachot*", an abandoned prison where Bernadette's impoverished family lived. Join your prayers with those of pilgrims from around the world as you pray for the sick, drink water from the miraculous spring the Virgin directed Bernadette to locate at the base of the grotto, and submerge yourself in the healing baths. Experience Christ's love as you walk the life sized Stations of the Cross overlooking the holy Grotto. Kneel in the chapel built on the very rock of the Grotto, in obedience to the request of the "*Immaculate Conception*." Our tour of Lourdes includes visits to the sanctuary, the *Basilica of St Pius X*, the world's largest underground church. Attend the blessing of the sick, and participate in nightly candlelight processions requested by Our Lady. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes. (Optional) Candlelight Rosary procession.

### JULY-31/LOURDES-LISBON-FATIMA:

Morning departure from Lourdes and transfer to the Toulouse for our flight to Lisbon. Upon arrival in Lisbon you will visit the church of *St. Anthony*. Despite what might be assumed from his name, Saint Anthony of Padua was born and grew up in

Lisbon. The location of his birthplace is in the crypt of the Church of St Anthony. Transfer to Fatima for dinner and overnight.

(Optional) Candlelight Rosary procession.

### AUGUST-1/FATIMA:

Today we will follow the Hungarian Stations of the Cross, along the Via Sacra culminating in the Chapel of Calvary, which overlooks all of Fatima. We will visit *Valinhos*, the site of Our Lady's appearance after the children's return from prison on August 19 and the *Hamlet of Aljustrel*, where the children lived. For lunch we will stop at the "*Centro Commercial Fatima*" and shop at the "religious super market" the biggest in Fatima. Late afternoon tour of the site of the apparitions and the *Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary*. This Sacred space contains the tombs of St. Francisco, St. Jacinta, and Sister Lucia. Continue with a visit to the *Holy Trinity Basilica*. The Church of the Most Holy Trinity is situated within the enclosure of the Sanctuary of Fátima, on the opposite side of the Basilica. It was inaugurated in 2007. Dinner and overnight in Fatima.

(Optional) Candlelight Rosary procession.

### AUGUST-2/BATALHA-NAZARE-FATIMA:

This morning after breakfast we will depart on a full day excursion to *Batalha* and Nazare. The Monastery of the Dominicans of Batalha was built to commemorate the victory of the Portuguese over the Castilians at the battle of Aljubarrota in 1385. It was to be the Portuguese monarchy's main building project for the next two centuries. Here a highly original, national Gothic style evolved, profoundly influenced by Manueline art, as demonstrated by its masterpiece, the Royal Cloister. Continue to *Nazare*, a colorful fishing village on a lovely bay, with a very long beach. The lower part of the town still consists of small lanes with fisherman huts. The district Sítio lies above approx. 100 m high cliffs. From there is a

fantastic view along the coast. You will have lunch and free time to explore the village on your own. We will also visit the *Shrine of Our Lady of Nazareth*. The legend of Our Lady of Nazaré is that the statue was carved in Wood by *Saint Joseph* himself and painted by *Saint Luke the Evangelist*, originated from Nazareth of Galilee and later taken to Europe.

Late afternoon return to Fatima.

(Optional) Candlelight Rosary procession.

### AUGUST-3/FATIMA:

In our last full day in Fatima, you will have free time for private devotions, last minute shopping or just explore Fatima on your own. After lunch the group will assemble for Mass and a visit the *Fatima Museum*, where you are able to see the crown of Our Lady with the bullet that injured John Paul II. (Optional) Candlelight Rosary procession.

### AUGUST-4/SANTAREM-LISBON-NY:

Today after breakfast we will travel to Santarem, one of the oldest cities in the world and venerate the miracle of the *Bleeding Host*. At the request of a sorceress, a woman stole a consecrated host from the church. On the way home the host begins to emit a brilliant beam of light and began to profusely bleed. Reverently returned to the church of *St. Stephen*, this miracle has been on continuous display since 1269.

After lunch you will be transferred to the airport for your return flight home.

You will be asking yourself, "Where did the time go?"
